









## Race registration opens at 8:30AM

Competitors may only complete registration **from 90 minutes** prior to his/her wave start time. Confirm wave start time on the E-Ticket in advance - registration cannot be processed more than 90 minutes before wave start time.

#### **NECESSARY ITEMS FOR REGISTRATION**

- Guardian's photo identification, e.g. passport, drivers license, MyNumber card, residence card, student ID, etc. (photocopies accepted)
- PRINTED E-Ticket
- · At registration, the competitor will receive a t-shirt in the pre-selected size
- Bring the aforementioned items to the race registration counter on race day.
   Spartan Race does NOT mail race packets in advance.
- ·From 2024, waivers must be signed electronically at registration on race day
- Upon completing race registration, collect race packet (items listed pg. 4).



# Bring the following items on race day:

- Guardian photo identification
- PRINTED E-Ticket

From 2024, waivers will be signed electronically on race day. SIgned waivers do not need to be prepared in advance.

### **Collect Race Packet**

Ensure race packet contains the following:



#### **Headband** (bib number)

All competitors must wear the provided headband; it should be visible during the race



#### **Category & Start Time Wristband**

A wristband indicating category and start time will be secured onto the competitor's wrist. Staff will confirm start time before the competitor's event. Do not remove wristband until after exiting the race venue.

#### **Eligibility Rules for Awards (Competitive only)**

- The start time wristband provided at registration must be worn during the race.
- In each category wave, boys will start first, followed by the girls.
- Competitive category competitors must complete 15 burpees with each failed obstacle.
- Those eligible for awards are encouraged to stay on-site and participate in the awards ceremony.

#### Awards: Top 3 Boys, Girls (10-11, 12-14)

- The top 3 boys and girls in the 10-11 and 12-14 age groups in the Competitive waves
  - will receive an award. Age group reflects age on December 31 of the calendar year
- Competitors receiving an award are encouraged to participate in the awards ceremony wearing his/her Spartan Kids finisher t-shirt on stage.
