NEW: Early Check-In for Spartan Race Niigata

For the first time ever, racers may check-in and collect their race packets in advance of race day! Skip the queues on race morning and be stress-free!

Friday, September 12 16:00-18:00
GALA Yuzawa Snow Resort

All are welcome, but racers registered for the BEAST Elite and Age Group are strongly encouraged to check-in on Friday. Merchandise will also be available for purchase - it's the ultimate pre-race experience!

- No parking available
- Racers are responsible for bringing their own race packets, including timing chips and wristbands to the race. Lost and misplaced timing chips, e.g. left behind at hotel, will incur a replacement fee.





RACE DAY CHECKLIST

Race registration counters open at 06:30AM

Racers may only complete registration no earlier than 90 minutes prior to his/her wave start time. Confirm wave start time on the E-Ticket in advance and complete registration 30 minutes prior to start time. Depending on start time, competitors competing in the earliest heats will have less time to complete registration. Long queues and crowding expected; plan accordingly.

NECESSARY ITEMS FOR REGISTRATION

- Photo identification, e.g. passport, drivers license, MyNumber card, residence card, student ID, etc. (copies accepted)
- PRINTED E-Ticket with wave start time (available from Sep. 11 18:00PM)

Multiple individual registrations can be processed at once. Racers are solely responsible for ensuring the correct headbands and timing chips are worn by each individual, for each race. Spartan Race will not be held responsible for irregularities, including disqualification due to competitor error.

Bring the aforementioned items to the race registration counter on race day. Spartan Race does NOT mail race packets in advance.

- Waivers must be signed electronically at registration on race day

Headband with bib number

You must wear the Spartan headband with bib number visible on forehead during the race.

• Wristband with start time

Secure start time band to wrist. You may only enter the wave corresponding to the time written on the wristband.

• Timing chip + yellow wristband

Secure timing chip on either wrist using the yellow wristband. Do not lose the orange timing chip; it will be collected by volunteers after crossing the finish line.

ELITE and AGE GROUP racers will receive a red head band



- Warm up and stretch on your own, then make your way to the start line 15 minutes before your race starts.
- Only warm up in the designated warm up areas; it is prohibited to warm up in parking lots and other areas not specifically designated for warm ups.
- Respect race staff and volunteers. They are out there for long hours to help enforce the rules and safety standards. Listen to them and help us thank them, it goes a long way.

RACE DAY PARKING

UNAVAILABLE

Do NOT park at restaurants, shops, and commercial facilities while at the race venue. Racers and spectators are advised to come to the race venue using public transportation. Personal vehicles MUST use public or paid parking lots in the vicinity or risk being towed at owner's expense.






By public transportation: Alight at Echigu Yuzawa station (Joetsu Shinkansen) and walk 20-30 minutes.

Alternatively, pre-book a shuttle bus ticket from JR Echigo Yuzawa station, East exit (duration: 5 min.) https://spartanraceniigatashuttlebus.com

By taxi: From Echigu Yuzawa station west exit, about 3 minutes Expect long delays for taxis

RACE REGISTRATION

Registration opens 90 minutes prior to the start time of each wave and must be completed 30 minutes before your start time. Racers with early start times may have less than 90 minutes to complete registration. Be at the start line 15 minutes before your start time.

STEP 1. Pre-race Preparation



STEP 1: Find Your E-Ticket (ONLY FROM 18:00 ON THURSDAY, SEP. 11)

- Click link to access My Account https://tickets-jp.spartan.com/my-account
- Login using your email address and password
- · Under My Account, click Orders
- Click the cog symbol and select PRINT TICKET
- E-Ticket will be displayed (see image)
- Click Print

RULES & REGULATIONS Official Spartan Race Rules of Competition



Obstacle categories are classified as:

- (1) Mandatory obstacles: an obstacle which a racer must complete before progressing further on the race course. Failure to complete a mandatory obstacle requires a penalty to be served by the racer
- (2) Pass/Fail obstacles: multiple or single attempt obstacles must be completed successfully, or a penalty must be served by the racer

Penalties to be served are as follows:

All protests must be made to the race director in-person at the Results booth on race day within 30 minutes of your finish. The final decision always rests with the race director, after which no further protests can be made.

Spectators, Photography, and Media Coverage

at both the start and finish. H

- Spectators are not allowed on the race course at any time.
- Providing aid and support that would give a racer an unfair advantage, including the provision of hydration, food, and material objects, as well as pacing, is strictly forbidden.
- · Racers may take still photography and film for personal use only. Any media taken must be limited to the racer's time on the race course. For example, a racer registered for the OPEN cannot enter the race course to film or take photos of ELITE or AGE GROUP racers on the race course.

The race director reserves the right to modify the course, competition rules, and race regulations under any circumstances for the safety of the racers, volunteers and staff. Similarly, the same rights apply pertaining spectator or racer entry onto the course, photography, and media coverage.

Spectator Areas

Two designated spectator areas at the start and finish areas will be provided at Spartan Race Niigata. The following rules apply:

- Children and women have priority
- Refrain from bringing and utilizing umbrellas (ponchos and raincoats recommended) and fragile items (including glass bottles)
- Large items and signage that obstruct others' view are not permitted
- Only the Spartan cowbell is permitted; other noise makers, including loudspeakers, whistles, drums, and sirens are not permitted
- Antagonizing or offensive speech and/or behavior pertaining to racers are not permitted
- Do NOT enter the race course or throw objects into the course





AFTER YOUR RACE

In coordination with event organizers, venue management, and relevant authorities, an official course closure and race venue closing time will be strictly enforced.

All competitors must cross the finish line by 16:30 (4:30PM), when the race course officially closes. Competitors who remain on the course after 16:30 will be marked as DNF (Did Not Finish). No medal or t-shirt will be given to competitors who finish after 16:30.

Spartan Race reserves the right to modify or close the race course for reasons pertaining to the health and safety of competitors, volunteers, and staff.

Timing & Results

- Preliminary race results can be checked at the Results booth or by using the QR code below and entering your bib number (the number on your headband).
- Official race results will be posted on the official Spartan Race website within five days of the race.

Water & Aid stations

- Water stations will be available on the race course.
- Keep hydrated and be aware of the signs of dehydration.
- · Competitors are encouraged to bring personal hydration packs and gear.

Competitors anticipating three hours or longer on the race course MUST bring personal hydration solutions.







RECOMMENDED ITEMS TO BRING

- Health insurance card or proof of health insurance
- Long sleeves, leggings, or compression gloves to prevent injuries on certain obstacles, such as the Rope Climb
- Fueling and hydration, including electrolytes, gels, and solid food
- Towel or body wipes
- · Heat and sun protection, including hats, sunscreen, ice rings, cold towels, etc
- · Cold weather and rainy day attire, such as windbreakers, rain jackets, arm warmers, etc.
- Moisture-wicking, quick to dry fabrics (not cotton)

Spartan Race Niigata is an endurance race in the mountains at elevation; prepare to spend several hours on the course, oftentimes in unpredictable weather

No showers available; temporary cold rinse shower areas available

Bathrooms


Available in the Festival Area. No bathrooms on course.

Bag Check

- Available at venue (¥1,000 per locker).
- Lockers are limited in quantity, consider sharing amongst friends and teammates.
- Personal items are solely your responsibility.

First Aid

- Teams of medical professionals deployed throughout the course.
- Medical tent available at Festival Area.







AWARDS

ELITE Top 3 and AGE GROUP podium winners will be announced on race day via official Spartan Race social media channels. Top 3 winners displayed on social media are official and final; no changes will be made once winners are posted on official social media.

Prizes and awards for the ELITE Top 3 Men and Women, as well as AGE GROUP categories can be collected at the Information booth. Due to the lack of appropriate space, no awards ceremony will be held.

ELITE TOP 3 MEN, WOMEN

The top 3 men's and women's finishers will be awarded at the stage on race day; prize money will be sent via bank transfer. Spartan Race will directly contact the applicable athletes.

AGE GROUP TOP 3 MEN, WOMEN

14-17 | 18-24 | 25-29 | 30-34 | 35-39 | 40-44 | 45-49 | 50-54 | 55-59 | 60+

The top 3 men's and women's finishers in each AGE GROUP category will be awarded at the stage on race day. Excludes OVERALL Top 3 winners. Age group reflects your age on December 31 of the calendar year.

BIGGEST TEAM

The top three biggest teams for each race category will be announced before race day via official Spartan Race social media channels.

BIG TEAM (Teams of 20 or more)

Teams of 20 or more competitors receive an original, personalized Spartan Race flag. Flags must be collected at the Information booth on race day.

IMPORTANT NOTES

THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS AND/OR ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED:

- Illegal parking, including parking at restaurants, shops, and commercial facilities while at the race venue. All vehicles parked illegally will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Warming up in restricted areas
- Cooler boxes and glass bottles
- Dangerous items
- · Refrain from calling GALA Yuzawa with questions about Spartan Race

LOST & FOUND

- On race day, all lost and found items will be kept at the Information booth at the Festival Area.
- Photo ID required to reclaim lost and found items.
- Neither Spartan Race nor the venue takes responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
